No matter what kind of adventure your in the mood for, Manitoulin Island has something for every taste!!

Hiking Trail Listings

1. **Lakeshore Trail**--Just outside of South Baymouth this trail follows roads beside the shore and includes Budd property.
2. **Gordon's Park**--Just outside Tehkummah and off of Hwy 6 this trail features outcrops, woods and exhibits.
3. **Fossil Hill**--Located at Hwy 6 and New England Road this trail features escarpment outcrops on EBC's reserve which demonstrates the life of 400 years ago.
4. **McLean's Park**--Off of New England Road and Hwy 6 it is a 100 acre park with hiking trails based on old logging roads.
5. **Eagles Nest**--Starting from McLean's Park up New England Road it features a pine forest, alvars and crevasses.
6. **Ten Mile Point**--Off of Hwy 6, Picturesque views await you as you descend the steep slope out to the Georgian Bay shore.
7. **Lewis Twin Peaks**--Located in Sheguiandah, this relatively easy hike this trail provides great views of Bass Lake and the North Channel.

8. **McLean's Mountain**--Off of Hwy 540 just outside Little Current, this trail provides spectacular views.
9. **Low Island**--A short accessible trail starting on the shore west of Little Current.
10. **Aundeck Omni Kaning**--This easy trail loops from Hwy 540 to the harbour.
11. **Dan Bingaman**--From the ski club chalet right before Honora Bay continue up the hill and follow the trail on the right.
12. **Honora**-- Follows Guida's side-road, along Honor Bay Road and south on Hwy 6.
13. **Bidwell Bog**--Located near Bidwell it was build to link the Cup and Saucer to Perch Lake.
14. **Cup and Saucer**--Located at Hwy 540 and Bidwell it features a variety of trails to suit everyone from beginner to expert.
15. **M'Chigeeng**--Located south from Hwy 540 on Hwy 551 this slightly more advanced hike features dramatic views.
16. **Bridal Veil Falls**--Located in Kagawong this picturesque hike is beautiful all year.
17. **Nimkees**--Located in Sheshegwaning The trail takes you along the shore and out to

Cape Roberts before heading inland to Shiniconing Bay.

18. **Misery Bay Trails**--Located 10 minutes west of Evansville off of Hwy 540, the three trails loop you through Ontario's best alvars.

19. **Wagg's Woods**--Right on the main street in Mindemoya, across from the library this trail takes you through dense deciduous forest before reaching low Escarpment outcrops beside a stream.
