

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
NORTHEASTERN MANITOULIN AND THE ISLANDS**

BY-LAW NO. 2007-22

Being a by-law to regulate the use of wheeled recreational devices,
within the town of Little Current.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, S. 130 provides that a municipality may regulate matters not specifically provided for by this Act or any other Act for the purposes related to health, safety and well-being of the inhabitants of the municipality:

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25. s. 128 provides that a local municipality may prohibit and regulate with respect to public nuisances, including matters that in the opinion of Council are or could become or cause public nuisances:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council for the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands hereby passes this bylaw which regulates & restricts the use of any wheeled recreational devices (excepting bicycles, but including skateboards, roller blades and scooters) to provide for the safety, health and welfare of residents of the community, and for the protection of people & property, on or near public places.

The use of skateboards, rollerblades and scooters is hereby prohibited at the following locations:

- On the sidewalk or roadway on Water Street between Sims Street and Hayward Street (the main street/downtown core)
- On or near the Cenotaph and public docks located in downtown Little Current
- On or near Manitowaning Road from Meredith Street to Water Street
- Upper Worthington Street for its entire length

First offence is a \$100 fine and any subsequent offences are \$150.00 and/or wheeled recreational device maybe subject to seizure for 30 days.
